

<u>Code</u>	<u>Key Responses</u>
Code Blue - Cardiac Arrest	Stand by to assist if needed if the patient is on your unit.
Code Pink - Infant Abduction	Detain persons with ways to conceal a child from leaving bldg.
Code Red - Fire	Pull fire alarm and activate PASS
Code Yellow - External Disaster	Report to designated area or labor pool
Code Green - Bomb Threat	Prepare for evacuation, record information if you receive the call.
Code White - Evacuation	Assist in moving patients and visitors from facility as directed
Code Purple - Radiation Exposure	Remove self from contaminated area and standby for directions.
Code Orange - BioTerrorism Emergency	Do not enter bioterrorism area, standby for directions.
Code Black - Internal Explosion	Prepare for evacuation.
Code Silver - Hostage Situation	Notify law enforcement and wait for instructions.
Dr. Strong - Combative Person	Report to designated area if you are on the Dr. Strong team only.
